VOTE NOVEMBER 8TH! The ballot is easy to fill out. All Democratic candidates are listed first for each office. Bring your friends, relatives, and neighbors with you. If you are not registered, **you can register at the polling place right before you vote.** To register at the polls, you **must have a PROOF OF**

RESIDENCE document (any document that contains a voter's current name and address, such as a bill, paycheck stub, or bank statement. It can be either a **paper copy, or one on your cell phone**) **You can still register to vote in person at your Municipal Clerk's office up until Nov 4th, the Friday before the election. You can also vote early while you are there. Might as well!** 😊

REMINDER: you will need to show a photo ID before you vote.

Will you need a ride to the polls? Call

Headquarters at 715-544-6323 and ask for assistance with transportation. We will find a ride for you.

To find your Voting Location visit: myvote.wi.gov. This is such a useful website! You can find a lot of election-related information here.

If you feel intimidated at the polls on election day follow these steps: (1) Do not engage and stay in line, (2) Inform a poll worker, (3) Call 866-OUR-VOTE (866-687-8683) to report it.
